Material Classification

Dirtworks classifies loads according to their moisture content, how compactable the material is, and material type. Classification is at the discretion of Dirtworks. *The following is intended as a guide only.*

Type 1: Clean/Dry Material - Dry material. Less than 5% concrete, asphalt, rubble, or vegetation content.

Type 2: Damp/Unsuitable - Damp/wet material or material with more than 5% rubble, concrete, or vegetation (this material is trackable).

<u>Type 3: Very Wet or Very Mixed</u> - Very wet material <u>or</u> material containing large quantities or pieces of concrete, rubble, and/or vegetation.

If there is more than 5% soil mixed with the concrete, then the appropriate soil classification above will apply. All concrete must have **NO** exposed/protruding rebar/mesh.

<u>Concrete 1</u> - Small pieces of clean concrete with minimal reinforcing.

Concrete 2 - Large pieces of concrete and/or reinforced.

<u>Concrete 3</u> – Very large pieces of concrete and/or heavily reinforced.

Slurry - Hydro Excavation material, or material so wet that truck tail gates need to be sealed. (We cannot accept any cess pits or septic material).

<u>Vegetation</u> – Green waste materials such as trees, plants, bushes and mulch.
